Other intended business includes approval of the Ministry Profile (includes job description) selection of Search committee and the approval of a new name for our Shared Ministry church.

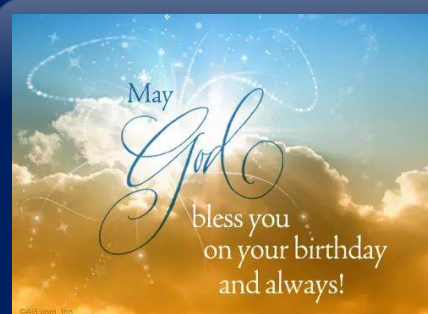

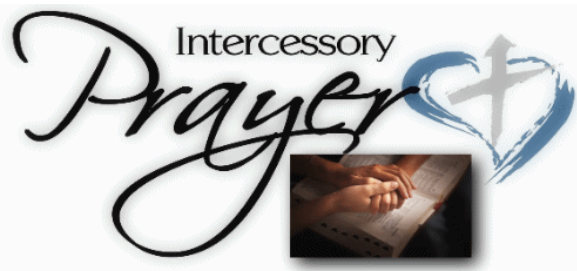
